

# NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING AND PROPOSAL TO ENGAGE IN A RENEWABLE ENERGY PROJECT

**Project Name:** Trillium Power Wind 1 (TPW1)

**Project Location:** The proposed Project area encompasses approximately 1.44 hectares onshore in Greater Napanee and 6,550 hectares offshore in Lake Ontario, approximately 35 km southwest of the City of Kingston.

**Dated at:** The Town of Picton this June 3, 2010.

Trillium Power is planning to engage in a renewable energy project with respect to which the issuance of a Renewable Energy Approval is required. The distribution of this notice of a proposal to engage in this renewable energy project and the Project itself are subject to the provisions of the *Environmental Protection Act (Act)* Part V.0.1 and Ontario Regulation 359/09 (Regulation). This notice must be distributed in accordance with section 15 of the Regulation prior to an application being submitted and assessed for completeness by the Ministry of the Environment.

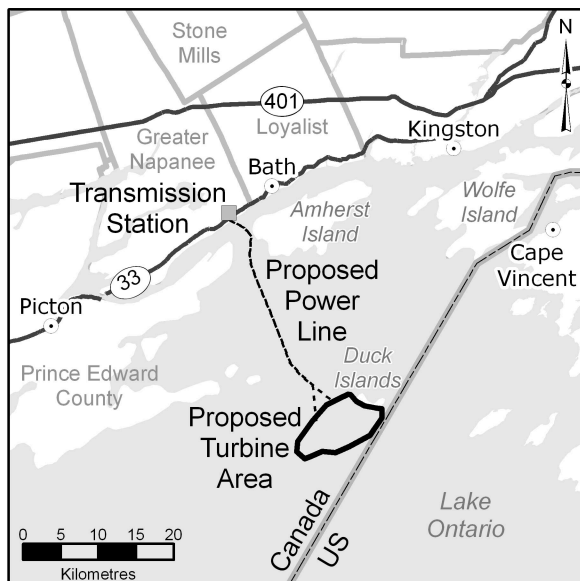
## Project Description

Pursuant to the Act and Regulation, the facility, in respect of which the Project is to be engaged in, is considered to be an offshore Wind Facility, Class 5. If approved, this facility would have a total maximum name plate capacity of 414 MW. The approximate centre of the Project area is located at 43 degrees 54 minutes West, 76 degrees 39 minutes North. The centre of the Project area is 17 km from the nearest shoreline in Prince Edward County and 28 km from the main shoreline in the Town of Greater Napanee. The facility will be constructed 500 metres southwest of Main Duck Island on the Ducks-Galloo Ridge, however no turbines will be installed on the island itself, as depicted in the map below.

## Documents for Public Inspection

The Draft Project Description Report titled Trillium Draft Project Description describes the facility as consisting of a total of 138 wind turbine generators. The major components of the Project are wind turbine generators; wind turbine and substation foundations; two above-water offshore substations; underwater transmission cables; switching station, staging and shipping areas, onshore operations and maintenance facility, and temporary laydown areas.
